EBC:

Benefit: 50% Tuition Fee & 50 % Examination Fee

- Student has to be admitted through Govt. CAP Round under Category OPEN and category for admission OPEN.
- Domicile Certificate of Student Compulsory
- Parents Income should not be more than 8 Lakhs (Income Certificate issued by the Govt. Tehsildar office compulsory and should be in the name of Father, If Father Expired Income Certificate should be in the name of Mother)
- For current Academic Year, only 2 children from one family are allowed for benefit of scheme.
- Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
- During course duration, candidate should not have a gap of 2 or more than 2 years.

- Student Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Compulsory
- Student Domicile Certificate Compulsory
- Student should produce income certificate in father's name provided by Govt. Tehsildar (*Valid up to 31st March, 2025*) Compulsory

OBC Category (Benefit 50 % Tuition Fee)

- CAP Round College Confirmation of admission letter Compulsory
- Student Caste Certificate, Caste Validity, NCL Compulsory
- Student Domicile Certificate Compulsory
- Student should produce income certificate in father's name provided by Govt. Tehsildar (*Valid up to 31st March, 2025*) Compulsory

SBC Category (Benefit 100 % Tuition Fee)

- CAP Round College Confirmation of admission letter Compulsory
- Student Caste Certificate, Caste Validity, NCL Compulsory

Benefit: 50,000/-

- > Student has to be admitted through Govt. CAP Round / Institute Quota / Institute Vacancy Round.
- ➤ Domicile Certificate of Student Compulsory
- ➤ Parents Income should not be more than 8 Lakhs (Income Certificate issued by the Govt. Tehsildar office compulsory and should be in the name of father. If father has expired, the income certificate should be in the name of mother)

> Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
